Urgent business

Chris B was unanimously elected our Alternate Treasurer, so she can open our new checking account and then be our second signer.

January minutes and treasury

Bob summarized January 2021 minutes and requested objections. There were none. Minutes approved.

Bob summarized January 2021 treasury report and requested questions:

Regarding our January and YTD profit and loss — Our total income for January was \$4,150,19, almost exactly 100% of our monthly income plan amount of \$4,150. Yay, God! January income was made up of \$2,941.92 in distributions from BDA Workshops; \$36 in gratitude contributions for member solvency anniversaries; \$12.77 in earmarked member contributions to public information; and \$1,160 in event proceeds from early registrations for the BDA and Visioning Mini-Conferences and continuing donations from Sunday BDA Phone's BDA Tool Two workshop series.

Total YTD contributions by groups through January 31, 2021 is:

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For total group contributions of \$3,726.42

Total YTD member contributions, both general and earmarked, are \$48.77.

Total BDA Intergroup event income is \$375.

For a combined total income of \$4,150.19 for the month of January.

Our expenses for January included: \$871.20 for a literature order from the GSO; \$561 for 51 eBooks; \$500 for two pre-imbursement to Nancy for mailing supplies and expenses; \$13.27 for paypal fees on BDA Tool Two workshop donations; \$203.45 for addition of two new urls -- helpfordebtors.org and hopefordebtors.org -- now mapped to bdaintergroup.org and renewal of the bdaintergroup.org url for two more years; and \$4,500 for our 25% deposit to the media company for our radio outreach project.

Regarding our YTD spending plan comparison for the month of January — We were \$0.19 (or 0.0%) ahead in income and \$848.92 under in expenses. The difference between our actual income and expenses remains in designated funds, leaving us with \$2,646.01 currently available in all funds.

We were over by \$932.20 in literature expenses for January. That is, our plan was \$1,000 and our actual was \$1,932.20. Since this is one of our two primary service areas, we consider this a good overage. Our literature service is being well-used by the fellowship. Our ending literature fund balance for January was \$349.84.

Regarding our balance sheet — As reported above, our total available balance in all funds at January 31, 2021 was \$2,646.01. We were only able to make accruals to our Literature fund (\$600), our tech and web fund (\$100), and our prudent reserve (\$100) in January, with no accruals made to Overhead or Public Information. Our ending unallocated balance in our General Fund was \$12.13.

Bob next asked for objections to approval. There were none. Treasury report approved.

Literature Coordinator — Nancy presented a literature report through February 26th, including inventory:

Newsletter Coordinator — March newsletter — volume 2, issue 2 — was approved by email and distributed on February 25, 2020 with an invitation to this, the February 28th, BDA Intergroup Project business meeting.

CLARIFICATION: This is not a media buy. We are paying a media company to produce both a 30-second audio Public Service Announcement (PSA) and a 60-second Audio News Release (ANR) and then to distribute them for us. This is not advertising or promotion (related to Tradition 11); instead it is the hiring of special workers (related to Tradition 9).

NOTE ON APPROVAL OF THESE SCRIPTS AND AUDIOS: Our group conscience for this project is primarily the two BDA Intergroup service members plus the Radio Project Lead; plus two other BDA members, one heavily experienced in Public Information in AA and one professionally experienced in Public Relations; and one past GSB Chair. We considered reaching out to the BDA and PI committees of the World Service Conference (WSC) but, since we're still not welcome to register with GSO, and the GSB is still refusing to recognize our existence, going around them to the WSC felt wrong.
